- Consider discussing concerns with parent

- Nominate a single point of staff contact
- Consider briefing other staff to manage on-going risks
- Maintain records relating to other agency interventions
- RECORD - ANALYSE - ASSESS and continue cycle

If the risk/issue cannot be resolved in-house: follow your school's child protection procedures and make a referral to MASH

- Explain to parents/carers that we will need to follow appropriate actions such as contact MASH
- Be highly sympathetic and reassuring
- Use collaborative approach: 'How can we help you?'

- Explain concerns and enquire into family circumstances and vulnerabilities that might exist in the wider family
- Assess whether risk can be resolved within school
- Consider support from your Safer Schools Officer or Prevent Lead
- Get advice + guidance from MASH
- RECORD - ANALYSE - ASSESS and continue cycle
